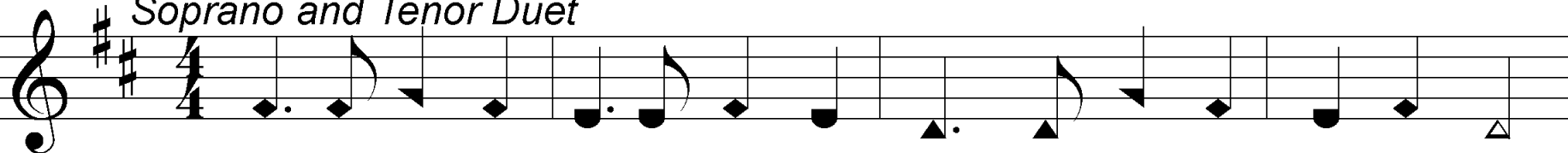

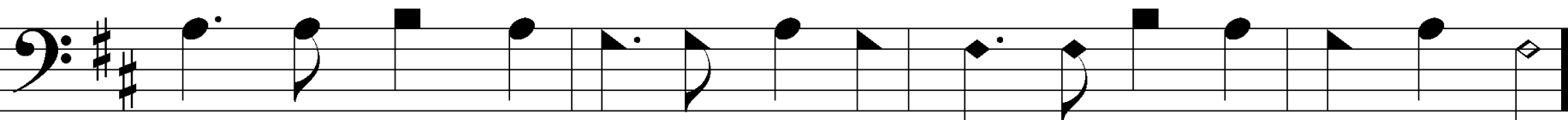


# 3 - All to Jesus I Surrender
