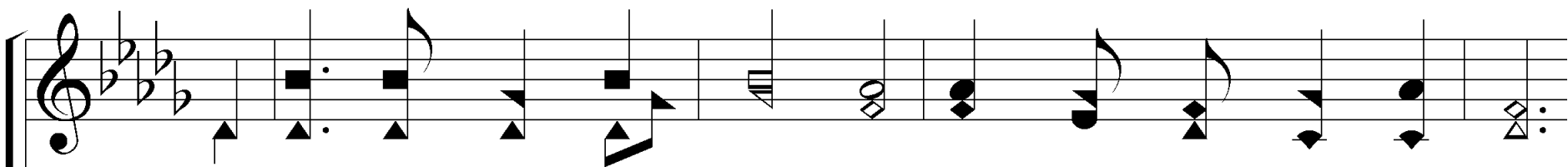
There is a place of quiet rest, Near to the heart of God,
